

Boarding ramp	Yes, on board and on station platforms Ramps are not required between Paddington Elizabeth line station and Woolwich due to level boarding
Scooter/mobility aid acceptance	Yes
Wheelchair accessible toilet	No
Standard toilet	No
On train staff to provide assistance	No
Audio information	Yes, through audible passenger information screens and a passenger announcement system
Visual information	Yes, through passenger information screens, signs and posters
Priority seating	Yes

The class 345 trains are compliant with PRM-TSI (Persons with reduced mobility technical specifications for interoperability) and include improved accessibility features such as four designated wheelchair spaces, priority seating, wide full-length carriages and improved customer information systems.




1.1 Class 345 seating plan




Wheelchair coaches




1.3 representation of passenger in priority area / wheelchair space


